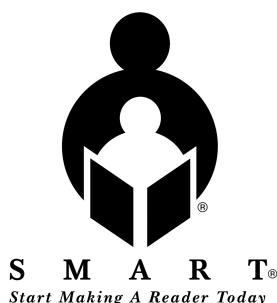


# Seeking volunteer SMART site coordinators for 2008-09 school year—apply today!



SMART (Start Making A Reader Today) is a book and reading program that builds literacy skills in K-3<sup>rd</sup> grade students by pairing them with community volunteers. With the help of thousands of volunteer readers, the program currently serves over 11,000 children in 275 schools. In 2008-09 we will need your help to bring SMART to Oregon's children.

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## Position: SMART Site Coordinator

**Description:** Implement SMART program and recruit, train & supervise volunteers in selected public elementary schools.

**Length of Volunteer assignment:** Sept. 2, 2008 – May 29, 2009 (following school schedule for holidays, etc.)

**Hours:** Programs run during school hours and number of volunteer hours is dependent upon school assignment.

### Numerous opportunities available:

- \* Volunteer to run an entire SMART program (two days or 10-20 hours/week).
- \* Job-share with one other volunteer (one day or 3-8 hours/week).
- \* Volunteer as part of a small team of coordinators (hours per week determined by the SMART manager and the team).
- \* Volunteer as a substitute coordinator at one school or substitute at several sites.

**Where can I Start Making A Reader Today?** At SMART school programs throughout Oregon.

The Portland metropolitan area includes Multnomah, Washington and Clackamas counties.
